Course Rationale

The Diploma of Commerce at Leaders Institute equips graduates with accounting management, marketing, economics, statistics, computer skills to thrive in today's competitive business and commercial environments. Graduates will know how to generate accurate financial and management reports for decision-making, communicate effectively, promote organisational change, manage people, and appreciate ethical business practices.

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Admission requirements

Admission is based on successful completion of one of the following:

- ✓ The Queensland Higher School Certificate or an interstate equivalent Higher School Certificate ATAR 60.
- ✓ Completion of an International Baccalaureate Diploma.
- ✓ Completion of an approved Certificate III or higher at a TAFE or Registered Training Organisation.
- ✓ Possession of qualifications deemed equivalent to any of the above qualifications.

International Students

International students who have not completed an Australian qualification must have qualifications deemed equivalent under the NOOSR guidelines. Applicants whose entry qualifications were obtained in an institution where English is not the language of instruction require an International English Language Testing Service (IELTS) of 6.0, with a score of not less than 5.5 in any of the four skill areas, or equivalent.

Note: International students must hold a valid Student Visa. There are numerous conditions that apply to a Student Visa. In particular, a holder of a Student Visa may not work, paid or unpaid, for more than 48 hours in any fortnight during semester time. Where Work Integrated Learning is integrated into a course, it does not count towards the 48 hours.
